Housing Programs

In 2015, our Center for Financial Advancement provided, foreclosure counseling, homebuyer education counseling and financial capability to **419** clients.

310 clients received foreclosure counseling and over

\$117,000 was distributed to help people pay their property taxes so they <u>could remain in their homes</u>.






HomebuyerEducation services where 55 went on to purchase a home and 32 received down payment assistance averaging \$7,500.



Over **3000** clients completed our financial counseling, of which 85% were able to find money within their budget to save or use toward paying down debt.





Our overall goal is to help our clients maintain financial self-sufficiency and achieve economic security in an effort to inevitably build wealth.

Our female mentoring program provides an environment for students to openly discuss issues related to self-image, anger management, goal setting, and social skill development. 82% saw an improvement in self confidence and 94% were able to solve problems and handle conflict better.

60% of housing counseling clients received information and referral for free, low cost or no cost healthcare services. This has increased their disposable income, and improved their wellbeing.






Where Did Our Revenue Come From?
